Whereas a Treaty of Peace and friendship between
the United States and the Piankashaw Tribe or Nation
of

of Indians was made and concluded at Portage des Sioux
on the Eighteenth day of July, one thousand eight hundred
& fifteen, by Commissioners on the part of the United
States, and certain Chiefs and Warriors of the Piankishaw
Tribe or Nation of Indians, on behalf of the said Tribe or Nation,
which Treaty is in the words following, to wit:

Now therefore be it known that I, James Madison,
President of the United States, having seen and
considered the said Treaty, have accepted, ratified
and confirmed the same, and every clause and
article thereof.

In testimony whereof I have
hereunto set my Hand, & caused
the Seal of the United States to be
affixed. Done at the City of
Washington this twenty-sixth
day of December, A.D. one
thousand, eight hundred &
fifteen, & of the Independence
of the United States, the fortieth.
